Library catalogues, databases, & course readings are most often used ~65%


Developing an outline is often undertaken for an assignment 78.9%

Passing the course is most important 98.5%


Students consult their tutor first and librarians last for information when preparing an assignment

Undergraduate vs Postgraduate Students




Considering the URL of web sources

Getting started on an assignment is difficult 54.9%

Knowing how good an assignment is, is difficult 68.6%

Information on social networking sites are rarely used 82.4%


Library and web sources are often evaluated for currency 92.2 & 84.3%

Deciding on search terms is often a first step for an assignment 74.5%


Passing the course & finishing the assignment are most important 98%

Nearly 30% of the undergraduates rarely or never consult their tutor about assignments
